Chairman Woodstead pointed out all exits and continued the meeting noting the delayed start due to a discussion with Dave from Goosetown regarding our radio and pagers. He then opened the floor for Public Comment. Hearing none he closed the Public Comment and moved on to the Secretary's Report.

<u>Special Meeting October 16, 2018</u> approved on a motion by Commissioner A. Ochs seconded by Commissioner T. LoBosco with Chairman Woodstead concurring. Absent were Commissioners D. Jacobsen and C. Rossi.

<u>November 14, 2018</u> Approved on a motion by Commissioner A. Ochs seconded by Commissioner T. LoBosco with noted corrections. Chairman Woodstead concurred.

Secretary Woodstead informed the Board of the need to set an Organizational Meeting date. The Board discussed this, and a date was set for January 9, 2019 at 6:00PM. The secretary was instructed to see to the posting of the notice.

Commissioner T. LoBosco requested the proper posting in-house of the Sexual Harassment Policy and Ethics Policy.

Noted was the attendance at the HGAC meeting with Santo Curro at South Salem Fire House. Commissioners then asked to have this added to our approved suppliers list on a motion by Chairman S. Woodstead seconded by Commissioner A. Ochs with all commissioners present concurring. Absent Commissioner D. Jacobsen.

Treasurer W. Wakeman then discussed the payment of bills. Added to the submitted of \$64,011.00 was the 3 checks of \$35 to cover the cost of Election Inspectors for the 12/11/18 Election.

Bills paid after the November meeting \$18,150.

Discussing the Budget, Board members on a motion by Chairman Woodstead seconded by Commissioner A. Ochs approved the transfer from equipment to cover all obligations in the Budget. All present commissioners concurred.

After reading the bills, Treasurer W. Wakeman asked the Board for guidance paying the BST invoice of \$7.500. The bill of \$8,500 last month was approved for only part payment pending receipt of required audits. She informed the Board nothing has come. On a motion by Commissioner T. LoBosco seconded by Commissioner A. Ochs the treasurer was instructed to hold off payment.

On a motion by Chairman S. Woodstead seconded by Commissioner A. Ochs, Treasurer Wakeman was instructed to put \$175,000 in the Equipment Reserve Account and to pay as many 2018 bills as possible. All present Board members concurred.

On a motion by Chairman S. Woodstead seconded by Commissioner A. Ochs the Treasurers Report was approved.

Chief's Report (hard copy attached)

Chief J. Peck reported 17 calls for the month.

November truck reports were submitted to District Manager Ritchey and Commissioner D. Jacobsen.

4th Quarter deficiency reports are to be submitted to A/C Peck for review in January 2019.

Chief's car will need a new driving light and the driver side inner door handle replaced.

In the future the Department will be planning to propose 3 new cheater lengths based off the 2018 Budget Equipment Priority List. Also need will be a spare halogen bar that was lost during a fire.

Chief J. Peck submitted a Training Status Report for the membership.

Dry Hydrants: Lake Kitchawan now in-service, Beaver Pond needs further testing.

Tanker 4 Committee working on specifications and a January – February opening bid.

60 Control has been contacted regarding communication problems.

Proposals

\$2,283 from AAA Emergency Supply Co., Inc. -3 Egress Bailout Systems, 3 Gemtor harnesses and Bailout Training for 3 Interior Firefighters.

Requested use of apparatus for 2019 events as broken down on his report.

Requested use of the firehouse for 2019 as broken down on his report.

On a motion by Commissioner A. Ochs seconded by Chairman S. Woodstead the Chief's Report was approved with all present Board members concurring.

<u>District Manager's Report (hard copy attached)</u>

District Manager T. Ritchey reported the repair of Engine 142 and needed repairs for Tanker 4.

Tanker 4 repairs could cost as much as \$11,500. Board members approved up to \$13,000 for this.

Ambulance 25(84B2) has had the needed repairs.

The problem with one phone line being out and the wireless internet not working was found to be a connection in the back of the modem.

Claim forms were sent in to the NYSDOH for reimbursement for 2 members who took the EMT class at Westchester Community College (\$700) each and for 2 members who refreshed (\$300) each.

E-mails and calls were made to carting companies that do business in Lewisboro and the following prices submitted: AAA Carting -4-yard dumpster \$236.50 + \$26 for recycling (2-96 gal. totes) = \$262.50

County Waste – 4-yard dumpster and 2-96 gal. Totes = \$230

Winter Bros. (now Oakridge Waste) 4-yard dumpster \$160 + \$30 for 2-96 gal. Totes= \$190

Board members approved the Oakridge Waste for January 2019.

District Manager Ritchey submitted his final vacation and holiday schedule.

The paperwork for VFIS to comply with the Cancer Law benefits starting 1/1/19 has been completed. 17 members are eligible at \$137ea. Total \$2,329.00

District Manager Ritchey will try to get Kinsley Power to replace the items listed in his report at a total cost of \$2,015.82.

District Manager Ritchey requested a new cell phone at state contract price as he is having problems with his present one. He stated he would have prices by January 2019 meeting. Board members stated since it was at state contract price to go ahead and get it.

Sprague Operation Resources (fuel oil) has been contacted and set up for automatic delivery every 2 weeks from now until the end of March.

Overhead Door company needs to be contacted for repair to the bottom section of one of the Ambulance Bay doors. District Manager Ritchey asked the Board if he could have them lube and check operation of all the bay doors. Board members agreed with this request.

The cement floor where it meets the door for Engine 143 bay has crumbled as well as cracks where the Tanker parks. District Manager Ritchey was directed to contact Randy Sant to have the floors repaired.

After three days wearing/testing PRFD's pagers on their 33.96 repeater the results were as follows:

Good coverage at the following locations: Soundview Loop, Serenity Place, Oakridge IAO Laurel Ridge Intelligible, but not good (static or other interference):

Vista FD (tested in it room, other locations are good.

Lake Kitchawan IAO lake parking lot

Cross River (outdoor coverage at best, nothing was received inside JJHS)

Unintelligible:

Elmwood x Wakeman Ridgefield Main St IAO RFD New Canaan Main St. IAO NCFD

Our coverage would be increased 50% at best off PRFD's repeater. This would be a very rough band aid solution to a problem that will likely still exist without installation of our own equipment especially given that county coverage for paging is not expected to be complete until 2026.

A meeting is set up for 12.20 at 10:00AM with fire County Control – "Why pagers aren't working".

The amplifier located in the radio room is out for repairs.

On a motion by Commissioner A. Ochs seconded by Commissioner T. LoBosco Chairman S. Woodstead adjourned the meeting at 9:23PM. All present Board members concurred.

# DISTRICT MANAGERS REPORT

December 12, 2018

## **APPARATUS**

Engine 142 has been repaired, the new charger was installed.

Tanker 4 went to Eagle Diesel Power and they found the transmission needed to be The cost will be 9,100.00 with 1 year parts and labor plus the 2,700.00 for the work that has been completed for a total of 11,800.00.

Ambulance 25 (84B2) - Received the front chrome wheel covers. Also, the broken lens cover has been replaced.

### MISC.

We had an issue with one phone line being out and the wireless internet not working. It was found that a connection in the back of the modern was switched for the phone line and there was a loose connection for the wireless router.

I sent in claim forms to the NYS DOH for reimbursement for 2 member who took the EMT class at Westchester Community College (700.00 each) and for 2 members who refreshed (300.00 each). We will see if we get it.

I sent emails and called each carting company that does business in Lewisboro and these are the prices I have come up with: AAA Carting - 4 yard dumpster 236.50 plus 26.00 for recycling (2 96 gal totes) which is a total of 262.50, County Waste - 4 yard dumpster and 2 96 gal totes for 230.00, Winter Brothers (now Oakridge Waste) - 4 yard dumpster 160.00 plus 30.00 for 2 96 gal totes for a total of 190.00.

As a reminder I will be using my remaining vacation time by taking Thursday and Friday (20 & 21) off, then half a day on Monday (24), Tuesday (26) off and half a day on Monday (31).

## **PURCHASES:**

I have completed the paperwork needed for VFIS to have us ready for the new cancer law benefits starting 1/1/19. We have 17 members that are eligible now at a price of 137.00 each

The last time Kinsley Power serviced the generator they stated that the radiator caps, engine block heater, heater hose and clamps need to be replaced. The total cost of the job is 2,015.82. I will try to get them to do it at the next service so we don't incur double travel

I am having issues with my phone and feel that it is time to look at purchasing a new one. I will look into them and have a price at the January meeting.

## **BUILDING:**

I contacted Sprague Operation Resources (our new oil company) and set us up for automatic delivery, every 2 weeks from now until the end of March.

I have to contact the Overhead Door company to repair the bottom section of one of the ambulance doors, the screws are pulled out and the bottom is now hanging. Would you like me to have them lube and check operation on all the other doors while they are here?

The cement floor where it meets the door for Engine 143s bay has crumbled on the left side and there are cracks on the right side. There are also cracks where the Tanker parks as well. We should get someone in to look at how it can be repaired, but it probably can not be done until the Spring because I am sure the truck(s) will have to remain outside.
